* Authorised carer under clause 30 or 31 of the Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Regulation 2012 (NSW) or a person applying to become an authorised carer under one of those clauses.

** The person applying for the WWCC must provide a valid medical certificate (issued within the last 6 months by a registered medical practitioner) stating that they are not physically capable of attending a Service NSW Centre.

What proof of identity documents do you need to provide?

You will need to provide a total of four (4) proof of identity documents:

- One (1) commencement of identity document (such as birth certificate)
- One (1) primary use in the community document (such as driver license)
- Two (2) secondary use in community documents (such as Medicare card and bank card)

The combination of the identity documents collected must contain the your:

- First name and surname in full
- Date of birth
- Photograph

Proof of identity documents must be certified true copies. A certified copy means a document has been certified as a true copy of an original by a person listed in Schedule 2 of the Statutory Declarations Regulation 2018 (Cth) – refer to <https://www.legislation.gov.au/Details/F2018L01296>

DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.

Commencement of identity documents – Provide 1 of the below

- Full Australian birth certificate (not an extract or birth card)
- Current Australian passport (not expired)
- Australian Visa current at the time of entry to Australia as a resident or tourist supported by current overseas passport
- Current ImmiCard issued by Department of Home Affairs (previously the Department of Immigration and Border Protection)

that enables the cardholder to prove their visa and/or migration status and enrol in services

- Current certificate of identity issued by Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) to refugees and non-Australian citizens for entry to Australia
- Current document of identity issued by DFAT to Australian citizens or people who have the nationality of a Commonwealth country for travel purposes.
- An Australian naturalisation or citizenship document (including Citizenship by Descent) issued by the Department of immigration and Border Protection.

Primary use in the community documents – Provide 1 of the below

- Current Australian driver license, learner permit or provisional license issued by a state or territory, showing a signature
and/or photo and the same name as claimed
- Current passport issued by a country other than Australia supported by your current Australian visa document
- Current proof of age or photo identity card issued by an Australian Government agency in the name of the applicant, with a signature and photo
- Current shooters or firearms license showing a signature and photo (not minor or junior permit or license)

Secondary use in the community documents – Provide 2 of the below

- Current Medicare card
- Current security guard or crowd control photo license
- Evidence of current right to an Australian government benefit (Centrelink or Veterans' Affairs). Card or interim letter are suitable evidence, statements will not be accepted.
- Current consular photo identity card issued by DFAT
- Current photo identity card issued by the Australian Defence Force
- Current Police force ID card issued to an officer by a police force
- Current Australian tertiary or secondary student photo identity document (if it does not have an expiry date and has only issue date, accepted up to 2 years from the date of issue)
- Academic transcript from an Australian university up to 12 months from date of issue
- Current credit or account card issued by a bank, building society, credit union, American Express or Diners Club International displaying the applicant's name and signature
- State/territory government rates assessment notice up to 12 months old
- Australian Utility bill showing the applicant's name and address up to 12 months old
- Bank statement or letter up to 12 months old, issued by a bank, building society, credit union, American Express or Diners Club International including the applicant's family name and first name in full, account number or account type, and financial institute letterhead or financial institute branch stamp.
