Code of Conduct Sample

What is a code of conduct?

A code of conduct (sometimes called a code of practice) is a guide of rules and ethics that describes the best approaches and actions that are best practice for an organisation or industry. Codes of conduct are designed to ensure that all employees, contractors, suppliers and other stakeholders who interact with the organisation in a business-to-business or business-to-consumer context, follow the same standards.

Key features of a code of conduct

- Defines the organisation's values
- Sets the standards for behaviour
- Provides a framework for decision-making
- Defines the consequences of non-compliance
- Provides a framework for monitoring and reporting
- Provides a framework for training and development

Key features of a code of conduct

- It should be clear, concise and easy to understand
- It should be relevant to the organisation's activities
- It should be consistent with other policies and procedures
- It should be regularly reviewed and updated
- It should be communicated to all employees and stakeholders
- It should be enforced consistently

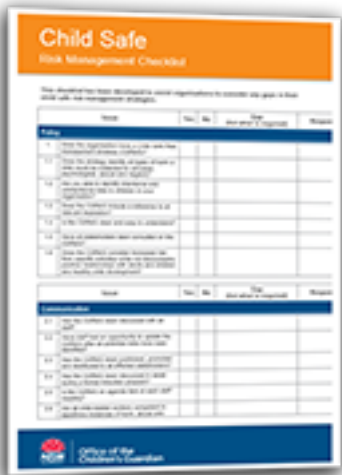
