## Register of authorised employers

The Office of the Children's Guardian regulates the employment of children under 15 years of age in the entertainment and exhibition, still photography, door-to-door sales industries and children under 16 years of age in the modelling industry.

Employers of children in these industries must have a valid Authority to employ such children in NSW and comply with the Code of practice, at Schedule 1 of the Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) (Child Employment) Regulation 2015.

Types of authorities:

- entertainment and exhibition
- still photography only
- door-to-door sales only
- student.

An Authority for entertainment and exhibition authorises an employer to employ children for film, television, theatre, still photography, catwalk modelling and other live performances.

Authorities are valid for either 1 week, 3 months, 6 months or 12 months. [Read more about authorities.](#)
